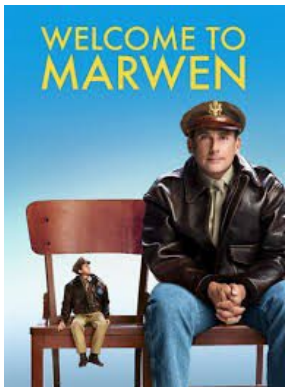

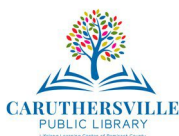
Doors open at 1:00 and the movie begins at 1:30
