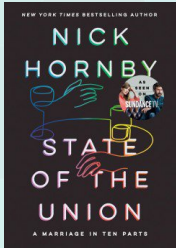
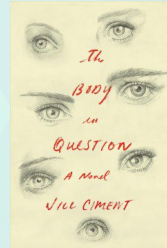

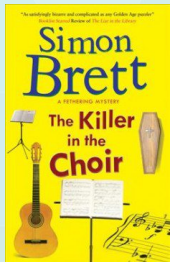
## State of the Union by Nick Hornby

A couple undergoes ten weeks of marriage therapy, forcing them to reexamine the true nature of their marriage and themselves. 132p



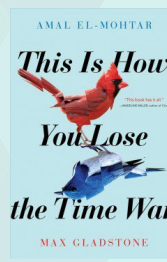
## The Body in Question by Jill Ciment

As a teenager stands trial for the murder of her young brother, two jurors fall into an affair that has wide-ranging fallout amidst public outrage over the verdict. 173p



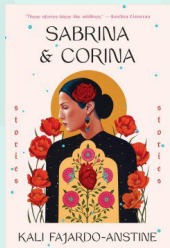
## The Killer In The Choir by Simon Brett

When the daughter of a deceased member uses the funeral to publicly accuse her stepmother of murder, Carole and her friend must unearth the truth. 184p



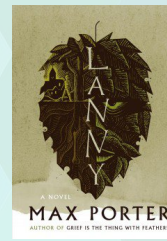
## This Is How You Lose The Time War by Amal El-Mohtar

Two time-traveling agents from warring futures, working their way through the past, begin to exchange letters and fall in love. 198p



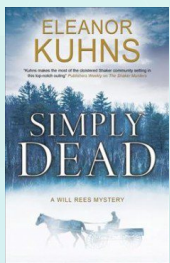
## Sabrina & Corina by Kali Fajardo-Anstine

Latinas of Indigenous descent feature in this story collection—a meditation on friendship, mothers and daughters, and the truths of our homelands. 212p



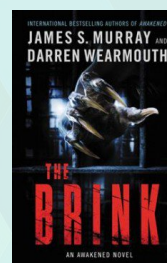
## Lanny by Max Porter
