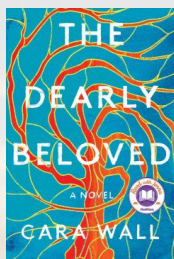
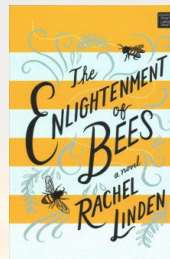

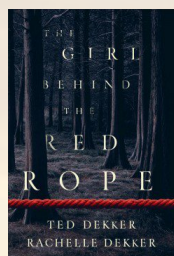
The Dearly Beloved by Cara Wall

The lives of two young couples become intertwined when the husbands are appointed co-ministers of a venerable New York City church in the 1960s.



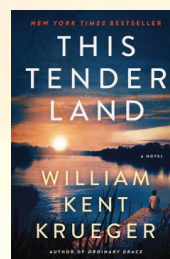
The Enlightenment of Bees by Rachel Linden

After being unexpectedly dumped, Mia joins a humanitarian trip around the world, where she learns valuable lessons and what she wants to do with her life.



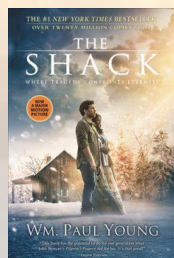
The Girl Behind The Red Rope by Ted Dekker

Grace lives in a religious community with strict rules meant to keep everyone safe, but the appearance of outsiders forces her to rethink her truth.



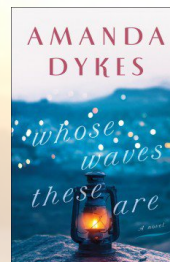
This Tender Land by William Kent Krueger

Fleeing a Depression-era school for Native American children, four orphans share a life-changing journey marked by faith healers and lost souls.



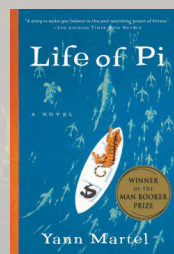
The Shack by WM Paul Young

Four years after his daughter is abducted and evidence of her murder is found, Mackenzie returns to the scene in response to a note claiming to be from God.



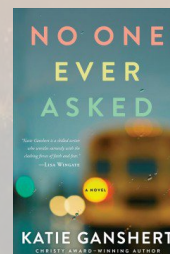
Whose Waves These Are by Amanda Dykes
