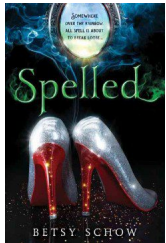

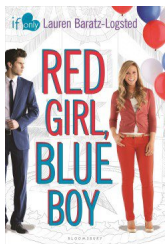

by Rachel Vail

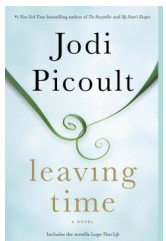

by Lauren Baratz-Logsted

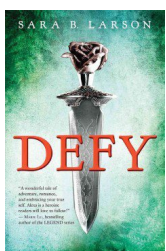

by Jodi Picoult

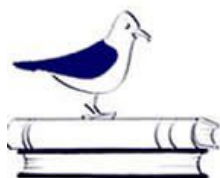
