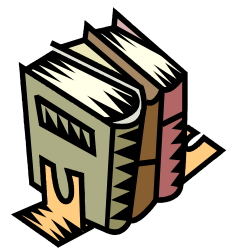

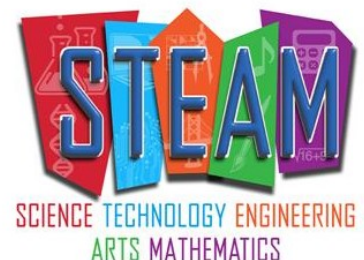
# Children's Department

## Happenings in the Children's Department at the Plymouth Public Library



**Lego Club** - On the second Tuesday of the month Lego club will be in the Guild Room from 4:00-5:30! Open to all ages with no sign up necessary! Legos will be provided by the library for you to build.

**Wonder Babies** - Tuesdays listed on the Calendar of Events. A Montessori based class for newborns to 4 years old from 9:30-10:30 will be held in Laramore Rooms A and B.
