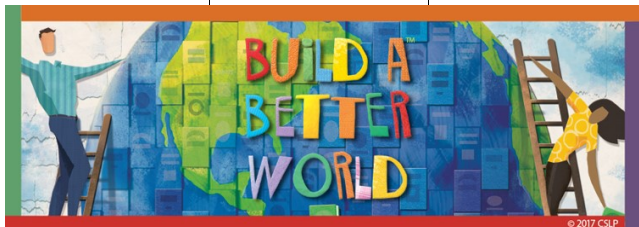

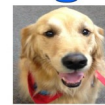


On Mondays and Wednesdays PHS students will provide homework help for students. No sign up required. Parents must stay in library if children are under 11 years old.

***Sign up and record books at the library website:**
www.plymouth.lib.in.us. Click on **Summer Reading Sign Up**.

***BE SURE TO READ** requirements for each reading program. They are posted in the programs when you sign up and record your books.

***Registrants for Summer Reading Programs must have a PPL library card in good standing. Library cards are free for people living in Plymouth city limits.** Center or West townships. Polk & North townships are able to get a PPL card according to trustees' agreements. Ask at Adult Circulation desk for information. PLAC or reciprocal borrowers may participate by having a PPL card in good standing and paying a small fee.

***Fun prizes will be awarded.** All readers may choose from an aisle that has prizes. **Food coupons and prizes will be awarded upon availability while supplies last.**

Information for the Grade the Child Completed

Infant-Preschool: Parents read books to their child. Prizes are awarded at 20 book intervals. If you read 100 books you complete the program!

Kindergarten and 1st Grade : Children if able, should read grade appropriate books by themselves. Prizes are awarded at 15 book intervals. If you read 75 books you complete the program! Board books are reserved for the Infant-Preschool level. You can record a title only once.

2nd & 3rd Grade: Students read grade appropriate books by themselves. Prizes are awarded at 8 book intervals. If you read 40 books you complete the program! You can record a title only once.

4th & 5th Grade: Students read **TWEEN** level books themselves. You can record a title only once. You earn 1 point by finishing 4 books. No graphic novels. Please pick up Official Rules at the Library or print them from the link on your log.
