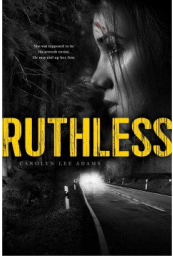


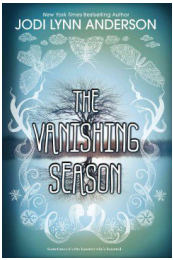

by Jodi Lynn Anderson

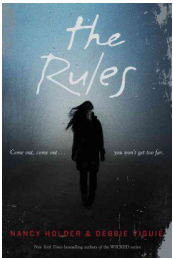

by Kate Brian

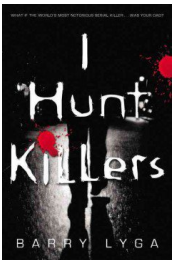

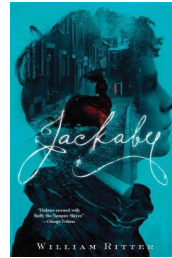

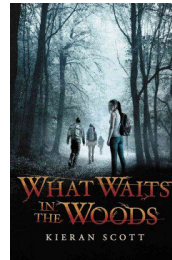


Jackaby

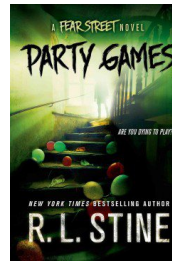
nonhuman creature
