Reading maps enable readers to follow threads of interest stemming from any particular part of the work, encouraging them to read further about these parts.

Ruth Ware is the British author of mystery thrillers. She grew up in Sussex, on the south coast of England.

After graduating from Manchester University she moved to Paris, before returning to the UK. She has worked as a waitress, a bookseller, a teacher of English as a foreign language, and a press officer. She now lives in London with her husband and two small children.

*In A Dark, Dark Wood* was Ware's debut novel, followed by her acclaimed and widely read *The Woman in Cabin 10*. She's been called the Agatha Christie of our time by many critics and has been dubbed a writer at the top of her game.

Actress and producer Reese Witherspoon has optioned *In A Dark, Dark Wood* for a theatrical movie while CBS Films has purchased the rights to *The Woman in Cabin 10* for a television movie.





A woman's horrifying discovery of human remains along a scenic tidal estuary reunites members of a clique from a boarding school whose actions contributed to the death of a teacher.




### *The Death of Mrs. Westaway*






