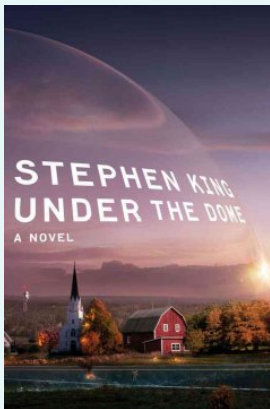

## Iona Iverson's Rules for Commuting

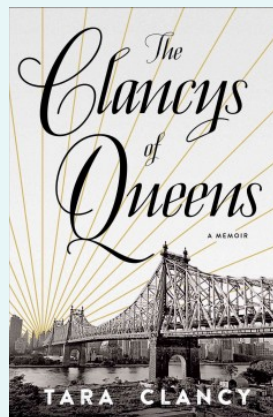
