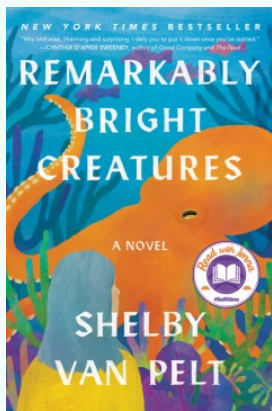

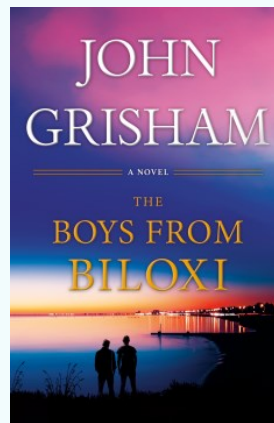

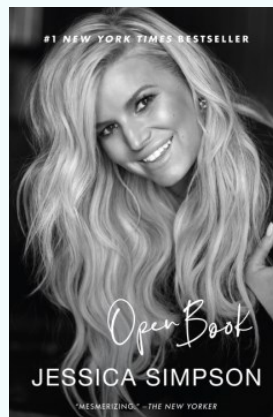
**Remarkably Bright Creatures**
