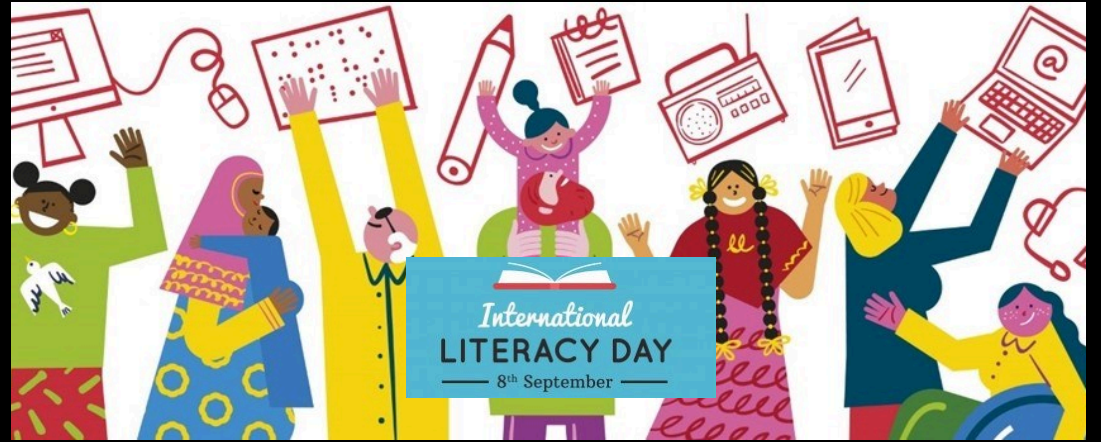

**September 20**



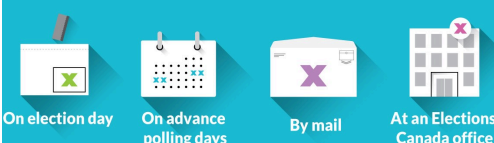
