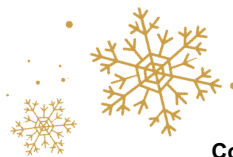

The First Nations, Inuit and Métis of Canada have a long and proud tradition of military service to our country.

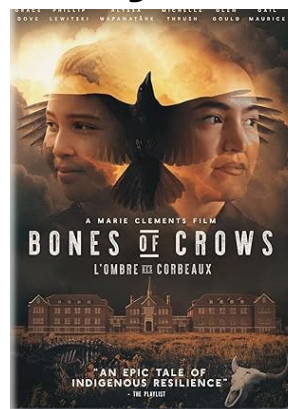
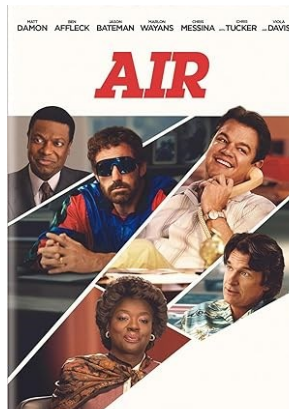
**November 11th is Remembrance Day**

Originally called Armistice Day, every 11 November at 11 a.m. It marks the end of hostilities during the First World War and an opportunity to remember everyone impacted by war.

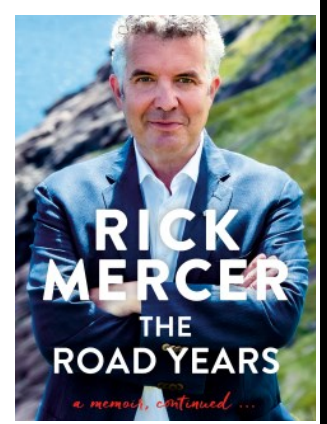
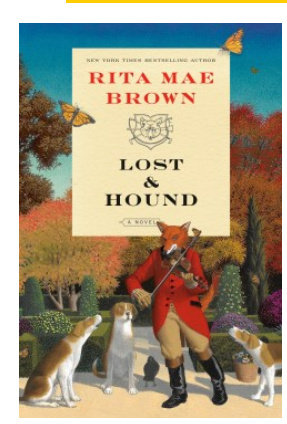
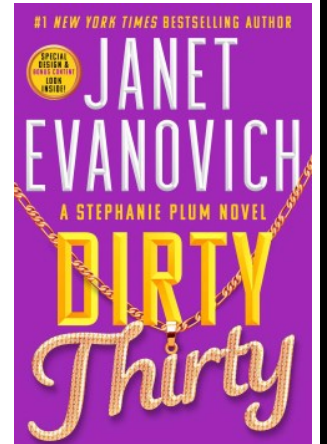
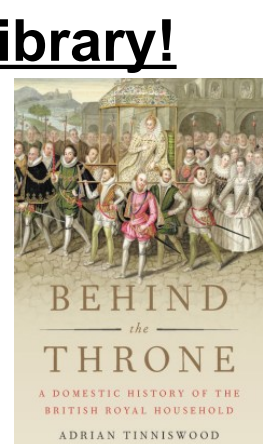
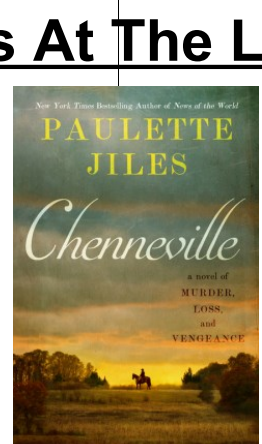
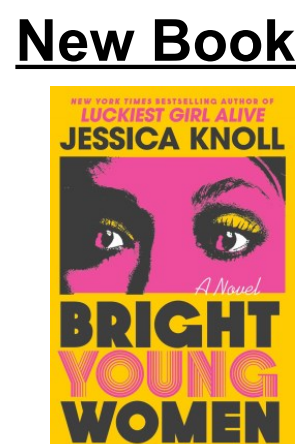
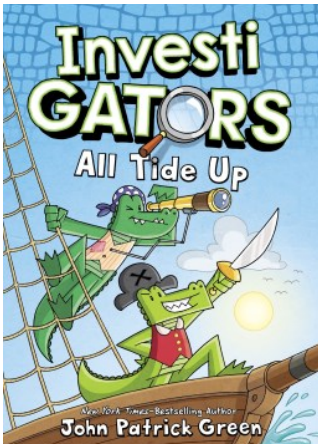
