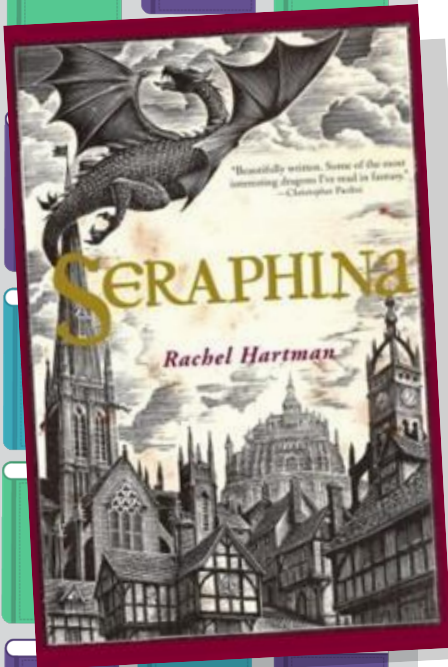


TEEN BOOK REVIEWS

Seraphina

Enchanting! Seraphina creates a human world where dragons exist, effectively combining children's fairytale creatures with medieval society. The book opens with court in an uproar over the decapitation of the crown prince. Despite relations with dragons being longstanding and amiable, it is suspected that dragons murdered the prince. Seraphina, the main character and court musician's assistant, has a secret. She's half-dragon, half-human. In a court where tensions between dragons and humans are high, this doesn't bode well for her. Despite trying her hardest to hide her mixed blood, it becomes difficult as the court begins to search for a dragon disguised as a human. This book follows her along her journey, while she juggles searching for the prince's murderer, coping with her family lineage, trying to hide her identity, and performing well as the musician's assistant.
