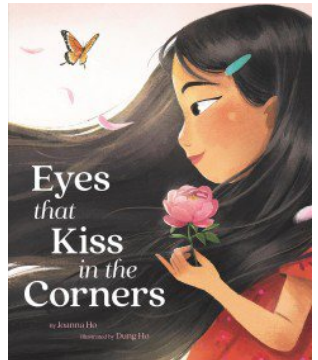


My First Day

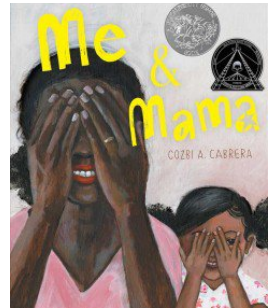


Eyes that Kiss in the Corners

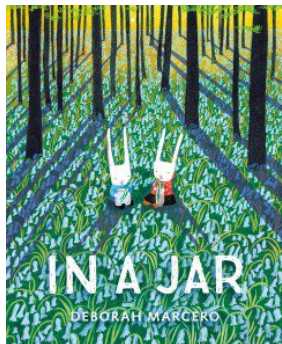


Me and Mama

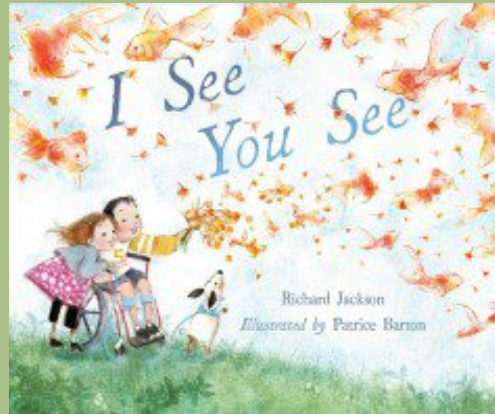


In a Jar

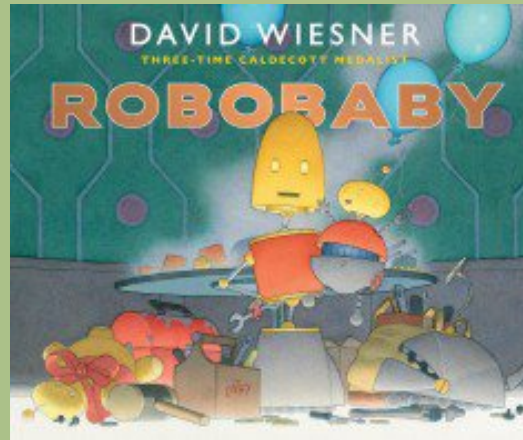


I See You See

Excited by the arrival of a new baby, a family of robots is nearly undone by technical difficulties until big sister steps in and repairs the situation.

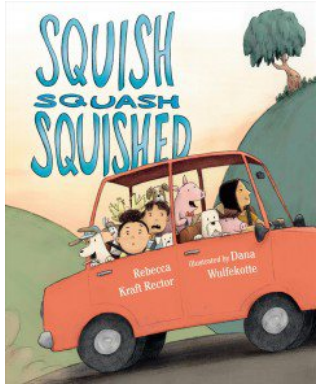

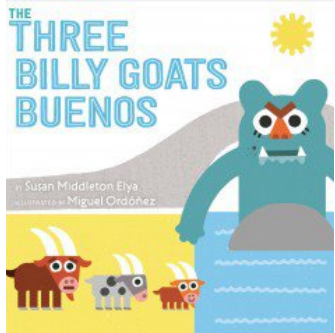


Squish Squash Squished

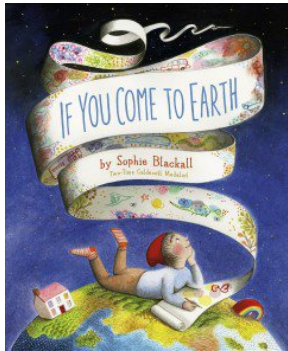


The Three Billy Goats Buenos

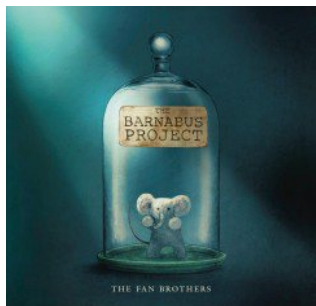


If You Come to Earth

A boy writes a letter to an imagined alien, explaining all the things he will need to know about Earth and the people who live here and adding a postscript asking what the alien might look like.

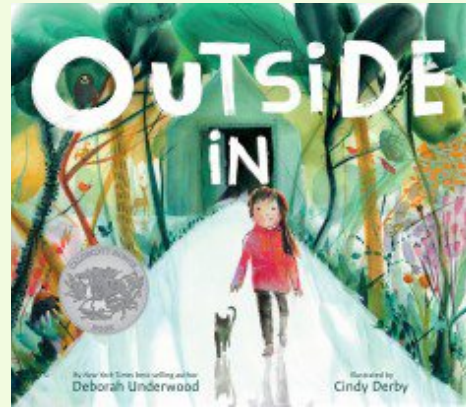

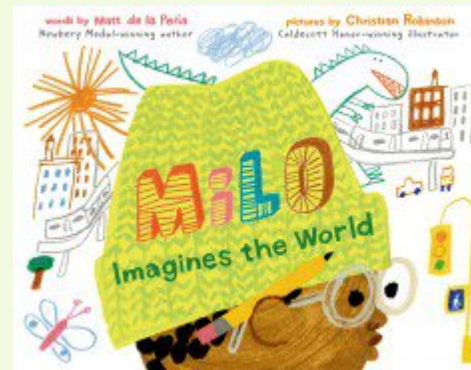


Outside In

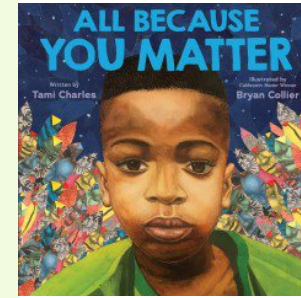


Milo Imagines the World

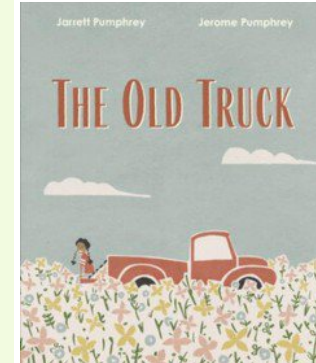

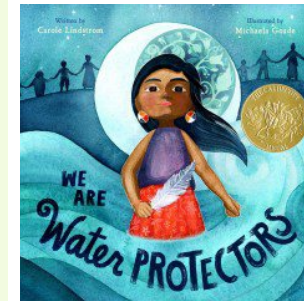


The Old Truck

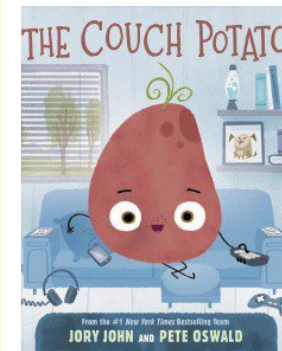


We Are Water Protectors
