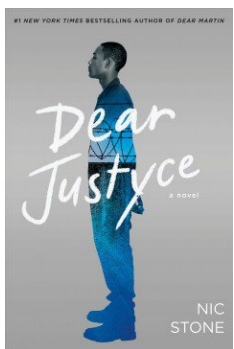

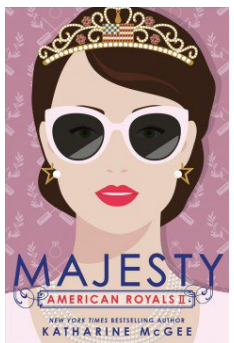
Together, Apart by Erin A. Craig

Incarcerated teen Quan Banks writes letters to Justyce McCallister, with whom he bonded years before over family issues, about his experiences in the American juvenile justice system.



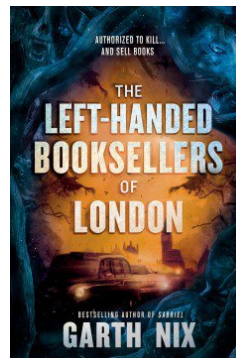
Majesty by Katharine McGee

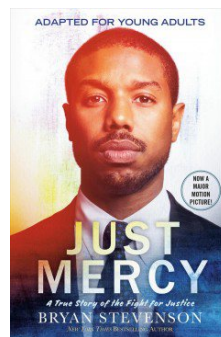
Princess on the Brink by Meg Cabot

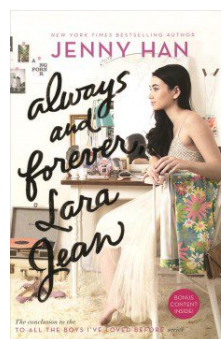
Just Mercy : adapted for young adults : a true story of the fight for justice by Bryan Stevenson
