



Homebound Service Application

Williamsburg Regional Library is pleased to offer free, personalized service for our homebound residents of the City of Williamsburg and James City County.

Williamsburg Regional Library defines homebound to mean that leaving home is a major effort for a period of 6 months or more. If leaving home, it must be to get medical treatment or for short, infrequent absences for non-medical reasons.

Homebound residents qualifying for full library privileges may be eligible for monthly delivery and pickup of library materials (books, DVDs, books on CD, music CDs) directly to their home. To receive homebound service, please complete the homebound application on this flyer. After receiving the completed application, a library staff member will call to set up a convenient time to:

- Review and sign the Home Delivery Service Letter of Understanding
- Discuss your reading/ viewing/ listening interests
- Discuss the delivery schedule
