


When Mr. Green, a stingy widower with three children decides to find a nanny he winds up hiring a glamorous ex-circus pig who knows nothing about children.

Gr 3-6 | ages 8-12




Avid baker Zoe Washington receives a letter on her twelfth birthday from her biological father, who is in prison for a terrible crime.

Gr 4-6 | ages 8-12



Gr 4-8 | ages 9-12






Winnie-the-Pooh

Gr. 2-4 | ages 7-12


The last thing Badger wants is a roommate, and certainly not Skunk. Soon everything in Badger's quiet and ordered life studying rocks is turned upside down.



Mr. Popper's Penguins


by Richard Atwater

Gr 2-5 | ages 8-12



Gr 3-5 | ages 8-12



Gr 3-6 | ages 8-12


When eleven-year-old Becca, a quadruplet, finds a sick piglet on the side of the road, her life is changed forever.



The Lemonade War



Gr 2-3 | ages 7-12


