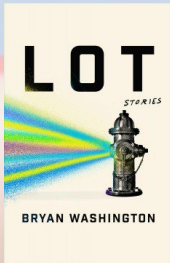
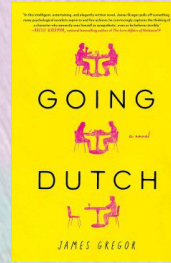

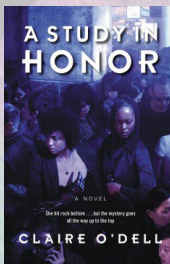
Lot: Stories by Bryan Washington

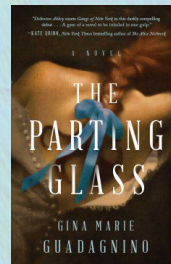
Going Dutch by James Gregor

Enmeshed with a straight woman, a 20-something gay graduate student soon finds himself on a romantic and existential collision course.



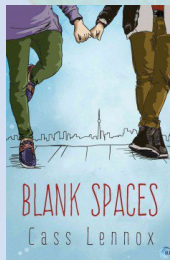
A Study In Honor by Claire O'Dell

Homeless and jobless after being dishonorably discharged, Dr. Janet Watson is offered a place to stay by mysterious covert agent Sara Holmes.



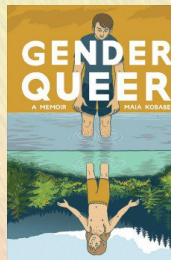
The Parting Glass by Gina Marie Guadagnino

A lady's maid leads a very different life at night as an Irish exile in New York's underworld, while her wealthy employer is having a secret affair.



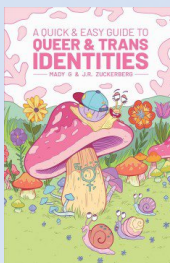
Blank Spaces by Cass Lennox

A guy who wants nothing but romance and a guy who wants nothing but sex will never work--right?



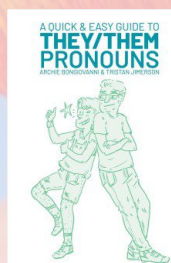
Gender Queer by Maia Kobabe
