

# WE'RE OPEN

## With Guidelines

Here's what you need to know.

While the green phase will facilitate a return to a "new normal," it will be equally important to continue to monitor public health indicators and adjust orders and restrictions as necessary to ensure the spread of disease remains at a minimum.



### LIMITED HOURS

We are open with limited hours.

Monday: 10:00 AM - 6:00 PM

Tuesday - Friday: 10:00 AM - 5:00 PM

Saturday and Sunday: Closed

Please note: Everyday the 10-11 AM hour is designated for our most vulnerable population.



### HEALTH AND SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

The well-being of our community and staff is always our top priority.

#### What we're doing to keep you safe:

- Offering times for seniors and those with health conditions to be in the library.
- Maintaining 6 feet of distance between each other.
- Following cleaning and disinfecting protocols put out by the CDC.

#### What we're asking you to do:

- Do not enter the library if you currently have or recently had a fever, cough, shortness or breath, or are feeling unwell.
- Keep your hands clean. Hand sanitizer will be available in the library.
- Maintain at least 6 feet of distance from others.
- Wear a face covering while inside the library.

#### What else you need to know:

- The library will be limited to 40 patrons at a time.
- The children's area is limited to no more than 20 people at a time.
- We recommend that one family member at a time come into the library.
- If you must bring a child with you, you must accompany them at all times.
- Please limit your stay to 30 minutes.



## LIMITED COMPUTER USE

- Computer sessions will be limited to 60 minutes per day by appointment only.
- Children's computers are closed until further notice.



## RETURNING ITEMS

- Our book drop is ALWAYS open.
- All library materials MUST be returned in the outside book drop before entering the library.
- Returned items will be quarantined for 3 days before being checked in.
- Do not bring in items that you wish to renew; just give us a call or let us know at the circulation desk what items you wish to renew.



## CHECKOUT AND PICKUP

- Currently, you may check out a maximum of 10 items per library card.
- Interlibrary Loan service will resume with new guidelines.
- Curbside pickup will be offered by appointment only for those with mobility and health issues.
- Desk pickup will be offered. Call the library at 724-458-7320 to request your items and we will have them available for you at the circulation desk the next business day.
