## BOOK ADVENTURE: EXPLORE HIDDEN HISTORIES

**Local history.** Find a family member, a family friend or a community member, and interview them about their life and experiences. How did their teenage years differ from yours? How were they similar? Ask them if they have any secrets or surprising stories from their past that they can share.

**Your hidden history.** If you don't already, start keeping a journal. As often as you can, write or sketch something that will help you remember how you felt or what you did on that particular day.
