BOOK ADVENTURE: EXPLORE ART

Art on the big screen. Watch a movie or documentary about street artists:

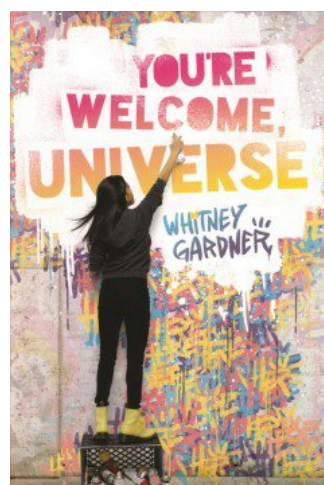
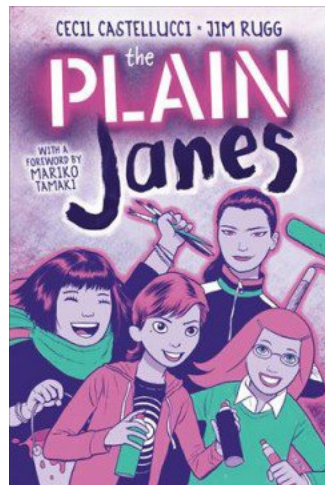
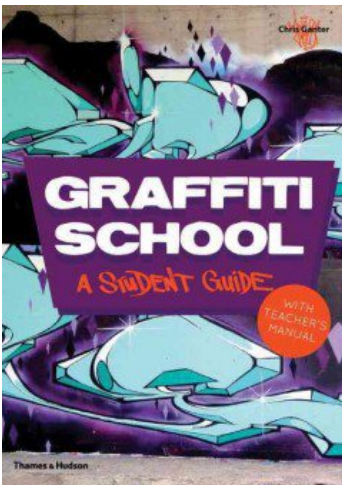
