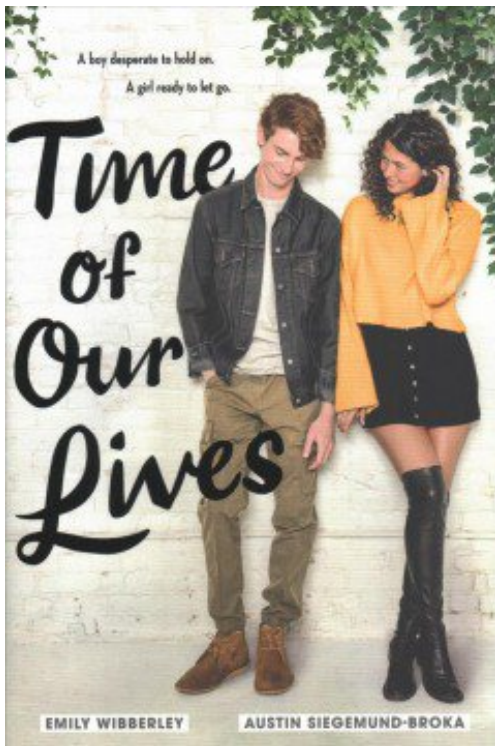


Teen Book Reviews

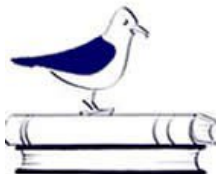


Time of Our Lives by Emily Wibberley **Genre: Romance (ebook)**

Summary: Fitz Holton wants nothing more than to take care of his mom, who he's slowly losing due to early-onset Alzheimer's. However, she wants him to follow and his brother, Lewis', footsteps and go to college. With much convincing, his mom convinces him to at least tour colleges in Boston. On a tour bus ride there he meets Juniper Ramirez, who unlike Fitz, is itching to leave home for college. After living with five rowdy siblings her whole life, she's ready for privacy and freedom. The two quickly become acquainted on their first tour and despite their family differences, find peace in one another and work to help each other through college, life, and fear of the future. The book was sweet and kind of simple, but in a good way. The chapters switch between the two main characters,

which is interesting because it gives you full perspective of what each person is feeling. You get what feels like a full story, which is really easy to follow. Also I didn't realize the book was written by two authors until I went to make my review. They blend their writing very nicely, the ideas were coherent and I never would've guessed it was a collaborative piece.
