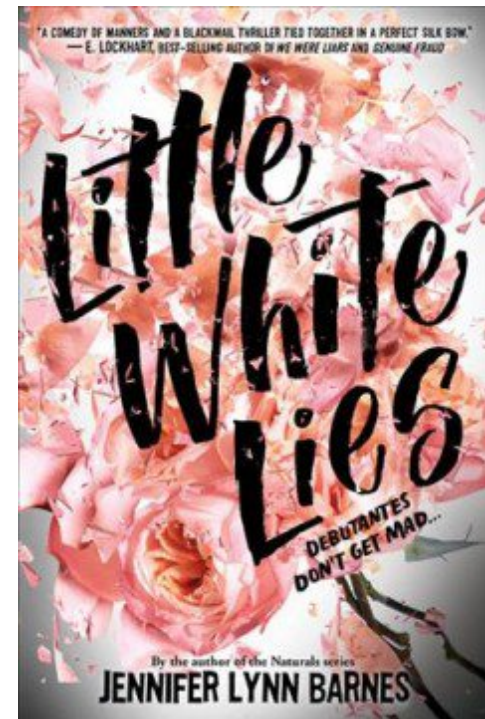


Teen Book Reviews



Little White Lies

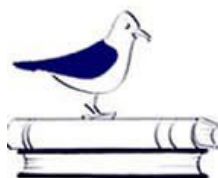
