

Won't You Be My Neighbor DAY


Wednesday, March 20

1000 BOOKS BEFORE KINDERGARTEN

Who can join? Your child from 0-5 years old.

What is the program? You and your child read together with the goal of reading 1000 books before they enter kindergarten.

Where does the program take place? Read to your child at home, at the library, on the go, or wherever you want. Storytimes at the library count!

When do I sign up? You can sign your child up any time! Stop by the Children's Department to sign up.

How do I keep track of the books? Once you sign up you will receive the first of ten different tracking bookmarks. For every book you and your child read, color in a star. Once you've filled in all the stars, bring the bookmark back to the library and get a prize, and your next bookmark. After you return 10 bookmarks, you and your child will have read 1000 books!

Why should I join? The 1000 Books Before Kindergarten challenge encourages academic success and school readiness. It shows kids that reading is fun, encourages bonding with the parent/caregiver, and gives your child the opportunity to feel proud of an accomplishment they have achieved.
