How do I read 100 books by graduation?

It's easy!

1 book every 14 days for 4 years = 104

25 pages per day for 4 years = 36,525 pages, approx. 104 books

1 book per week for 2 years = 104

Do we have to read only books from the Library?

Nope! Any age appropriate book counts. No matter where you get them or how many times you read them — they all count! Including graphic novels and manga!

Do e-books or audiobooks count?

Absolutely! Reading an e-book or listening to an audiobook totally counts as having read the book. You can read books in whatever way and format works best for you.

Setting aside a few minutes a day to read has great benefits. Plus, you'll receive prizes along the way!



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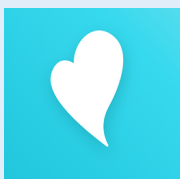
HOW IT WORKS
