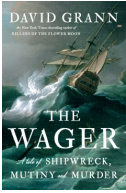
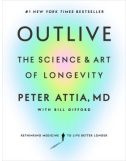

The survivors of a shipwrecked British vessel on a secret mission during an imperial war with Spain have different accounts of events.



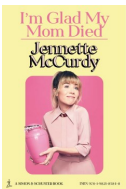

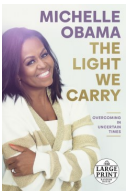

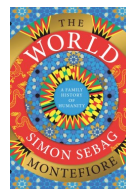

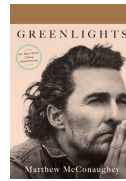
