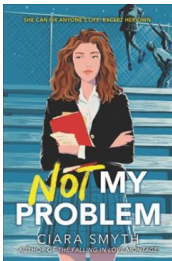

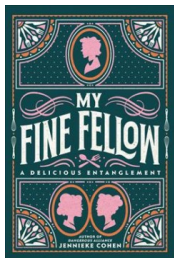

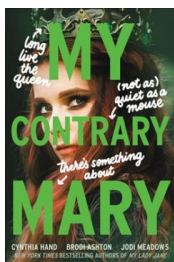


My Fine Fellow

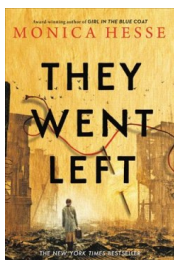


My Contrary Mary

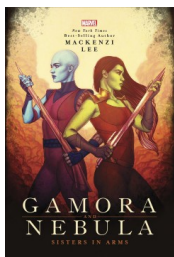


They Went Left

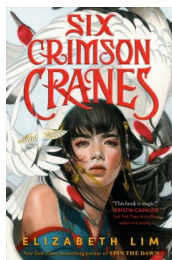


The Wide Starlight

Pinky and Samir pretend to date each other to achieve their respective goals during a Cape Cod summer, with disastrously uproarious results.

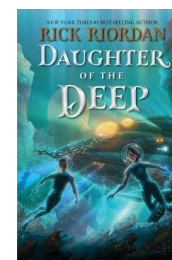
