


Spark and the Grand Sleuth




Rise of the School for Good and Evil

Two brothers—one good, one evil—choose the students for the School for Good and Evil where they train, teach, and prepare them for their fate until the unexpected happens.




The Total Eclipse of Nestor Lopez




The Forest of Stars




The Hidden Knife
