


Wrong Place Wrong Time




My Wife Is Missing

When a woman disappears with her two children, her husband will do anything to find them, even confront the secrets of his own past.




The Maid




The House Across the Lake




Steel Fear






Take Your Breath Away




Counterfeit




Razorblade Tears

When his son and husband are murdered, ex-con Ike Randolph bands together with his father-inlaw, another ex-con, to rain down vengeance upon those who hurt their boys.




Rock Paper Scissors
